BROAD STREET GATEWAY IMPROVEMENTS Doylestown Borough, PA

As the Borough Engineer, Gilmore & Associates, Inc. (G&A) assisted the Borough of Doylestown with all aspects of the Broad Street Gateway Improvement project. This project, which was broken into three phases, was made possible through the receipt of \$1.5 Million in transportation Enhancement (TE) grant funding. Phase I of the project included the installation of a small pocket park at the intersection of Broad Street and Sandy Ridge Road. The park, designed by G&A, has a flag-stone walkways, a bituminous bike path, landscaping, and a decorative sign wall. Phase I also included paving and street print.

Phase II included the installation of raised crosswalks and landscaped islands on Broad street between Atkinson Lane and Union Street, curb improvements, and concrete sidewalk removal and replacement to facilitate pedestrian and bicycle traffic. Also included in Phase II was the installation of additional handicap ramps. Phase III included the installation of approximately 60 street trees to serve as a buffer between the bike/hike path and the heavy traffic entering the Borough via the Route 611 ramp to Broad Street. This phase also included the installation of approximately 64 historic street lights.
